



San Francisco's Presidio is undergoing an enormous transformation. After 225 years as a military post — first Spanish, then Mexican, and finally American — it has been made a National Park. Now Dennis and Doris Fisher are proposing to donate their world-class modern art collection — and a museum to house it — to the City of San Francisco and erect it located in the Presidio. The question "where in the Presidio is the best location for a modern art museum — a very complex and controversial

question — is best answered with a simple gesture: place the Contemporary Art Museum at the Presidio (CAM) underneath the Main Parade Ground. The historical context will be restored and the parade ground converted to green space of world parking will be restored. The overlay air underlay in the case of a new cultural park with the most historically revered site in the Presidio advances the cultural contributions of the National Park while retaining the historical context and open space.
